Private or Semi-Private Classes can be scheduled through the office.

### Payments Terms / Refunds

Tuition is payable in two installments: 50% on the first day of class (deposit will apply to this payment), the remainder on February 1, 2011. A non-refundable registration fee of \$20.00 (\$25.00 per family) will be added to all tuition fees. Payments received more than one week after the due date will incur a \$10.00 late fee. Each subsequent week will incur an additional \$5.00 late fee.

### Discounts

Discounts are applied to families whose child takes more than one class per week or for families with more than one child enrolled. Discounts are as follows:

2<sup>nd</sup> class or child - \$25      3<sup>rd</sup> class or child \$35      4<sup>th</sup> and subsequent classes or children \$50

Discounts apply only for students enrolled for the entire Fall Session (September –June). Discounts can not be applied to Discovery, Semi Private, Private or Pointe Classes. **Refunds are granted solely at the discretion of management** for problems such as serious illness. In the case that the management determines a refund is in order, the student may be charged only for classes taken and prorated at the single class rate as posted in the office, (not the discounted full session rate.)

### Registration

Registration may be completed in person on specified registration dates, or by mail or email. If registering by email, a check must be received within 2 working days to hold your spot in class. An E-mail notice will be sent before the first day of class to inform you of any problems with your registration.

### Make-up Policy

Students may make-up missed classes any time throughout the session in any equivalent class. Students are welcome to use make-ups to try other genres of dance – e.g. ballet students may make-up in a jazz or modern class. No refunds will be given for missed classes, nor may make-ups be carried over to another session.

### Pointe

Pointe classes are offered for the more advanced student ready to take on the rigors of this challenging art form. The ability to dance on pointe requires a substantial knowledge of vocabulary as well as understanding and proficiency in ballet technique including body alignment, strength, and balance. At the Intermediate II Ballet level (Pre-pointe), students start to exhibit the necessary elements and more serious students interested in pursuing pointe are required to take 2 ballet technique classes per week. Pointe students are required to take AT LEAST three ballet technique classes per week but are strongly encouraged to take 4 -5 ballet classes. Pointe students who opt to take only 3 classes per week should be aware that their progress on pointe will be significantly impacted by this choice. Intermediate IV students are required to take four technique classes per week.
